CELEBRATION OF MARRIED LIFE: There will be a special Celebration Mass for Married Life on Saturday 17th May 12 Noon at Leeds Cathedral for couples and their families celebrating their 25th (Silver), 40th (Ruby), 50th (Golden), 60th (Diamond) and 70th (Platinum) wedding anniversaries this year. ASSISTED SUICIDE BILL ACTION: The Committee Stage of the Assisted Suicide Bill has ended. The Bill is now weaker and less safe than it was before. 300+ amendments that sought to strengthen safeguards in the Bill and protect vulnerable groups were rejected by Bill supporters, including protection for people with disabilities and domestic abuse victims. CHILDREN'S LITURGY: There will be Children's Liturgy on Easter Sunday during 9.15am Mass. Thereafter it will be on the first Sunday of the month.

ILKLEY FOODBANK: Ilkley Foodbank was established by Churches Together in Ilkley many years ago. We currently have 73 client households in the Ilkley area and provide food for around 200 - 210 people per month. In recent months there has been a noticeable reduction in the amount of food donated by the public, which has meant that we have to spend more of our cash in buying supplies. In February we had to spend more than £1100. Our reserves are being depleted, so we are asking those who can do so to consider making a regular gift to the Foodbank. Our bank details are Ilkley Foodbank, the Co-op Bank, Sort Code: 08-92-99, Account Number: 67225145. Because we are a registered charity, we can claim Gift Aid on donations made by UK taxpayers.
